Third Party Plugin Managers

- vim-plug
- Vundle
- NeoBundle
- Pathogen

Required for Vim version 7 and earlier.

How to Find Plugins

Search using Google.com or VimAwesome.com.

Tip: use `/` to search, `J/K` to navigate, `N/P` to flip pages

How to Install Plugins

Plugins are typically hosted on GitHub.com.

You'll need Git on your system for Vim 8.

`dnf install git` # RedHat, etc.

`apt install git` # Debian, etc.

`https://git-scm.com/` # Windows.

`git clone https://github.com/plugin-path`

Vim 8 Packages / Plugins

Plugin support is built into Vim.

Functionality was released in 2016.

How to confirm your version of Vim:

```
vim --version
```

```
vim
```

Where Packages Are Stored

`{packpath}/pack/{package-name}`

Examples:

`/home/jason/.vim/pack/git-plugins`

`/home/jason/.vim/pack/vendor`

`/home/jason/.vim/pack/myplugins`

`C:\Users\jason\vimfiles\pack\git-plugins`

Where Packages Are Stored

`{packpath}/pack/{package-name}/start/{plugin-name}`
`{packpath}/pack/{package-name}/opt/{plugin-name}`

Examples:

`/home/jason/.vim/pack/vendor/start/nerdtree`

`/home/jason/.vim/pack/vendor/opt/ctrlp`

`/home/jason/.vim/pack/myplugins/start/nerdtree`

Loading Optional Plugins

```
:packadd {plugin-directory-name}
```

Example:

```
:packadd vim-fugitive
```

This searches for "pack/*/opt/vim-fugitive" in the packpath.

Example: ~/.vim/pack/git-plugins/opt/vim-fugitive

Summary

- Plugins add functionality to Vim.
- Search for plugins or use VimAwesome.com.
- Packages group plugins together.
- To autoload a plugin, place it in "start/".
`{packpath}/pack/{package-name}/start/{plugin-name}`
- To manually load a plugin, place it in "opt/".
`{packpath}/pack/{package-name}/opt/{plugin-name}`

Summary

- Plugins are typically installed using git:

```
git clone https://github.com/plugin-path
```

- Remove a plugin by deleting its directory.
